



It is important to know that you may only use images from the internet from sources where photographers have given you permission to do so. One source is called Flickr Creative Commons. Here is how to get images from Flickr and give correct attribution to their creators.

Go to:

<http://search.creativecommons.org/>

In the search box enter your search term and click on the **Flickr** box.



Select an image

Confirm that the picture is available for you to use



means you are required to attribute the work to the original author in the manner they have specified. You must also be careful not to imply that the original author has endorsed you in any way through your use of the item.

Copy and paste the image, giving the creator credit using format below:
