

World War II Infographic

Information graphics or **infographics** are graphic visual representations of information, data or knowledge. They have a unique ability to deliver information quickly and clearly. Instead of reading paragraph after paragraph of text, information seekers can gain knowledge through graphic or pictorial components that have been chosen, arranged and emphasized to create a powerful and efficient message.

They are not new, but technology has made it easier to produce and distribute them, making infographics very popular in contemporary marketing.
